FACILITIES: In the Valley Station there is a gift shop and outside patio. In the Mountain Station there is a gift shop, Peaks restaurant for fine dining, Pines Café for casual dining, cocktail lounge, natural exhibits, State Park visitor's center and documentary films about the Park and the Tram history. Groups up to 100 can be accommodated in Peaks Restaurant with its beautiful view of the Coachella Valley. There are picnic areas and observation points with telescopes at both stations. V.W. Grubbs View Point at the southeast corner of the Mountain Station offers 360- degree views of the desert floor and Wilderness area.

NOTE: The Tramway's Mountain Station is currently under renovation and all private banquet facilities are unavailable. The natural exhibits and State Park Visitor Center has been relocated. Please check the information signs. Peaks Restaurant and Pines Café are scheduled for renovation as well at a later date. Please check with the PSAT Sales Department for dates. Tentative completion date is early 2021. We apologize for the inconvenience.

AT THE TOP: Within Mount San Jacinto State Park and Wilderness area are some 50 plus miles of hiking trails, primitive campgrounds and picnic areas. A permit is required for any hiking or backpacking in the Wilderness. This is obtained, free of charge, from the Long Valley Ranger Station at the top of the Tramway. During the winter months with sufficient snow coverage, the Adventure Center will open for cross-country ski and snowshoe equipment rentals. No reservations, first come first serve.

PARKING: The parking fee for cars and vans is \$8.00 per car/van. The parking fee will be waived for buses and customers with local ID. Please prepare to stop and pay at the security gate.
