PALM SPRINGS AERIAL TRAMWAY ANNUAL MAINTENANCE CLOSURE

September 9 Through October 6

PALM SPRINGS, CA (August 20, 2024) The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway will close for annual maintenance beginning Monday, September 9, through Sunday, October 6 with a tentative reopening date of Monday, October 7 at 10:00 a.m. The last day to ride the Tram before the annual maintenance closure is Sunday, September 8.

"During this year's shutdown, we will be performing a track rope repositioning, which ensures even wear of the cables," says **Vice President of Tramway Systems Chris Bartsch**. "Additionally, we will be conducting annual state-permit testing, and our Switzerland-based technicians will be performing necessary annual service and upgrades."

Tramway General Manager Nancy Nichols explains, "The Tramway's annual maintenance closure allows our maintenance team to perform complex projects that cannot be completed during normal business hours. We appreciate the understanding of the community and look forward to welcoming them back in October."

The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway is the world's largest rotating tram car. Opened in 1963, the Tram's 80-passenger cars travel along the breathtaking cliffs of Chino Canyon from the Valley Station (elevation 2,643 ft.) to the Mountain Station (elevation 8,516 ft.) in approximately 10 minutes.
