## **2025-2026 GROUP RATES**

The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway has the world's largest rotating tram cars which carries visitors from the Valley Station, elevation 2,643 feet, to the Mountain Station located at the 8,516-foot level of Mt. San Jacinto State Park and Wilderness.

<u>OPERATING HOURS:</u> Monday through Friday first Tramcar up is 10 a.m. Saturday, Sunday and holidays first Tramcar up is 8 a.m. Last Tramcar up is 8 p.m. and last Tramcar down at 9:30 p.m. Tramcars depart at least every half hour.

**CLOSURE DATES:** (see page 2 for holiday blackout dates). The Tram closes every year for annual maintenance. The tentative closure dates for 2025 is September 8 through October 12, 2025 with the first group bookings available on October 20. Dates are subject to change.

**GROUP RESERVATIONS:** Two-week advance reservation is required for any group. In order to obtain a group rate, one person must purchase all the tickets upon arrival and all must ride-up together (no individual arrivals). The reservation confirms your group's arrival time, not the departure time. No group reservations accepted on holidays and holiday weekends.

Groups of 25 or more with advance reservations — Without Dessert: Adult - \$36.00; Children (ages 3-10) - \$26.00 or with Dessert: Adult - \$39.00; Children (ages 3-10) - \$29.00. (Holidays excluded).

Ride N Lunch is prepared especially for your group, therefore a credit card is required and will be charged for the confirmed number of guest 5 business days prior to the visit. If number of guest is not confirmed or if lunch group has not canceled 5 business days prior to the visit, the original reservation number of guest will be charged to credit card on file. If the group cancels 5 business days prior to visit no fees apply. A contract for signature will be provided to confirm the reservation and to agree to the reservation policy.

## **BLACKOUT DATES (HOLIDAY PERIODS):**

Martin Luther King Jr. Weekend; President's Day Weekend; Easter Sunday; Memorial Day Weekend; 4th of July Holiday; Labor Day Weekend; Thanksgiving Day Weekend; Christmas and New Year's Holiday (December 20, 2025 through January 4, 2026).

**METHOD OF PAYMENT:** The Tramway accepts the following forms of payment: cash, credit card, cashier's check, money order or company check. Personal checks are **NOT** accepted. Please call the group sales department for further information.

**FACILITIES:** In the Valley Station, there is a gift shop and outside patio. In the Mountain Station, there is a gift shop, Peaks restaurant for fine dining, with its beautiful view of the Coachella Valley, Pines Café for casual dining, cocktail lounge, natural exhibits, State Park visitor's center and documentary films about the Park and the Tram history. There are picnic areas and observation points with telescopes at both stations. V.W. Grubbs View Point, at the southeast corner of the Mountain Station, offers 360- degree views of the desert floor and Wilderness area.

**AT THE TOP:** Within Mount San Jacinto State Park and Wilderness area are 50+ miles of hiking trails, primitive campgrounds and picnic areas. A permit is required for any hiking or backpacking in the Wilderness. This is obtained, free of charge, from the Long Valley Ranger Station at the top of the Tramway. During the winter months with sufficient snow coverage, the Adventure Center will open for cross-country ski and snowshoe equipment rentals. No reservations, first come first serve.

**PARKING:** The parking fee for cars and vans is \$15.00 per car/van. The parking fee will be waived for buses and customers with local ID. Please prepare to stop and pay at the security gate.
