EXTENDED HOURS FOR MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. WEEKEND AT THE PALM SPRINGS AERIAL TRAMWAY

PALM SPRINGS, CA (January 7, 2026) The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway will operate holiday hours January 17 - 19 in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day. The first tram up each day will be at 8:00 a.m., the last tram up will be at 8:00 p.m., and the last tram down will be at 9:30 p.m.

Tram admission is \$34.95 for adults, \$31.95 for seniors (65+), and \$18.95 for children ages 3-10.

Special discounts and packages are available after 4:00 p.m. Twilight tickets are \$31.95 for adults and seniors, and \$15.95 for children ages 3-10. Ride 'n' Dine tickets, which include tram fare and dinner at Pines Café, a cafeteria-style restaurant, are \$41.00 for adults and seniors, and \$27.50 for children ages 3-10.
