Tramway Closure Due to Technical Issues

PALM SPRINGS, CA (May 3, 2026) Please be advised that the Palm Springs Aerial Tramway is currently closed due to technical issues.

The Tramway suspended operations at approximately 11:25 a.m. on Sunday, May 3 and patrons already at the Mountain Station were transported down throughout the afternoon.

Updates will be provided when more information is known.

The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway is the world's largest rotating tram car. Opened in 1963, the Tram's 80-passenger cars travel along the breathtaking cliffs of Chino Canyon from the Valley Station (elevation 2,643 ft.) to the Mountain Station (elevation 8,516 ft.) in approximately 10 minutes.
